1. Overview

FontWizardXT adds the following EPS-Export functions to QuarkXPress™:

- Embedding of all used fonts
- EPS-Export of multiple pages with one command
- EPS-Export of parts of a page
- Creation and use of export-styles similar to print styles
- Adding of distiller commands for exact PDF-page sizes (TrimBox)

2. System requirements

- MacOS X 10.3.9/10.4
- Windows 2000/XP
- QuarkXPress™ 6.5

3. Installation

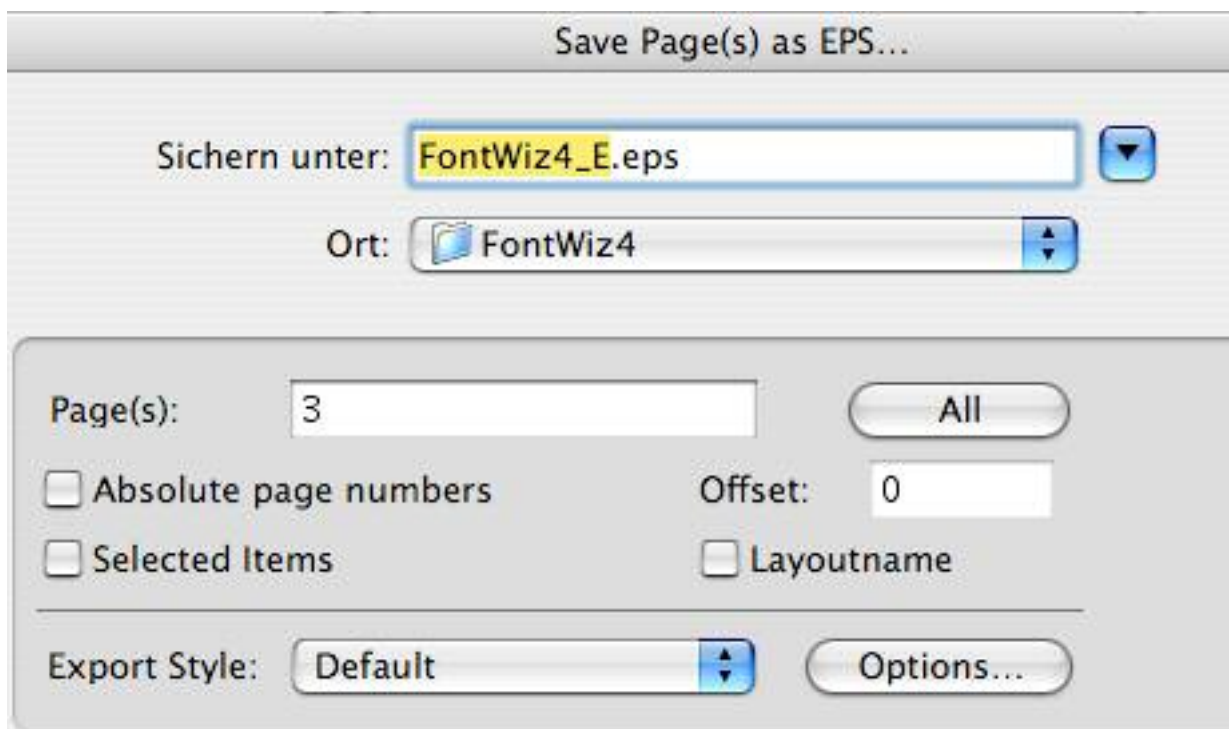
The file “FontWizardXT.xnt” has to be copied into the folder “XTensions” of QuarkXPress™. After restarting QuarkXPress™ FontWizardXT is ready to use.

4. FontWizardXT EPS Export...

FontWizardXT adds a menu item “FontWizardXT EPS Export...” to the QuarkXPress™ menu “Utilities”.

4.1 Save Page(s) as EPS

After selecting the menu item “Utilities->FontWizardXT EPS Export...” the following dialog is shown:



Save Page(s) as EPS...

With this dialog the destination and name of the resulting EPS file(s) is specified. There are additional options available:

- *Page(s):*

With FontWizardXT it is possible to save more than one page of a document as EPS-files with one command. The resulting EPS-files get unique names by adding the page number and the “.eps” suffix to the file name, e.g. Document1_1.eps (see chapter 4.3 for details about page numbering).

- *All:*

With “All” the page range is set to all pages of the current document.

- *Absolute page numbers:*

The page numbers of a document must not start with 1, but can start with any number the user wants to. By default FontWizardXT uses these “logical” numbers for specifying pages. With “Absolute page numbers” the page range is specified with absolute page number from 1 to n, with n the number of pages in the current document.

- *Offset:*

With absolute page numbers active it is possible to enter an offset here. This offset is added to the number at the end of the eps file name.

- *Selected items:*

If some boxed of the current document are selected, you can save only the bounding box of the selection as a EPS-file by activating “Selected items”.

- *Layoutname:*

If you want the base name of the eps file the layout name instead of the project name, check this option.

- *Export Style:*

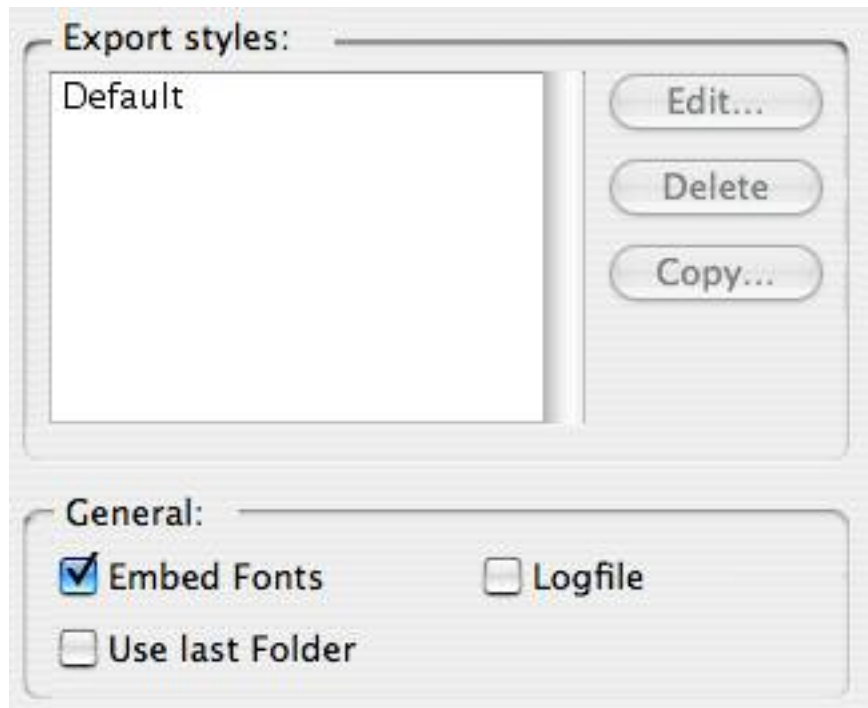
With “Format” the desired export style can be selected.

- *Options:*

With “Options” it is possible to change the settings of the chosen export style for the next job. After exporting the document the settings are restored to their original values.

4.2 Preferences

It is possible to define one or more export styles similar to print styles. By choosing “Utilities->FontWizardXT...” with no document open or by “QuarkXPress->Preferences->FontWizardXT...” the following dialog is shown:



Export Styles

- *Embed Fonts:*

Font embedding can be switched on and off for each style, but this only applies to eps-files created via “FontWizardXT EPS Export”. If the standard dialog is used or if the eps is created by another XTensions™ software, font embedding can be activated and deactivated with this option.

- *Logfile*

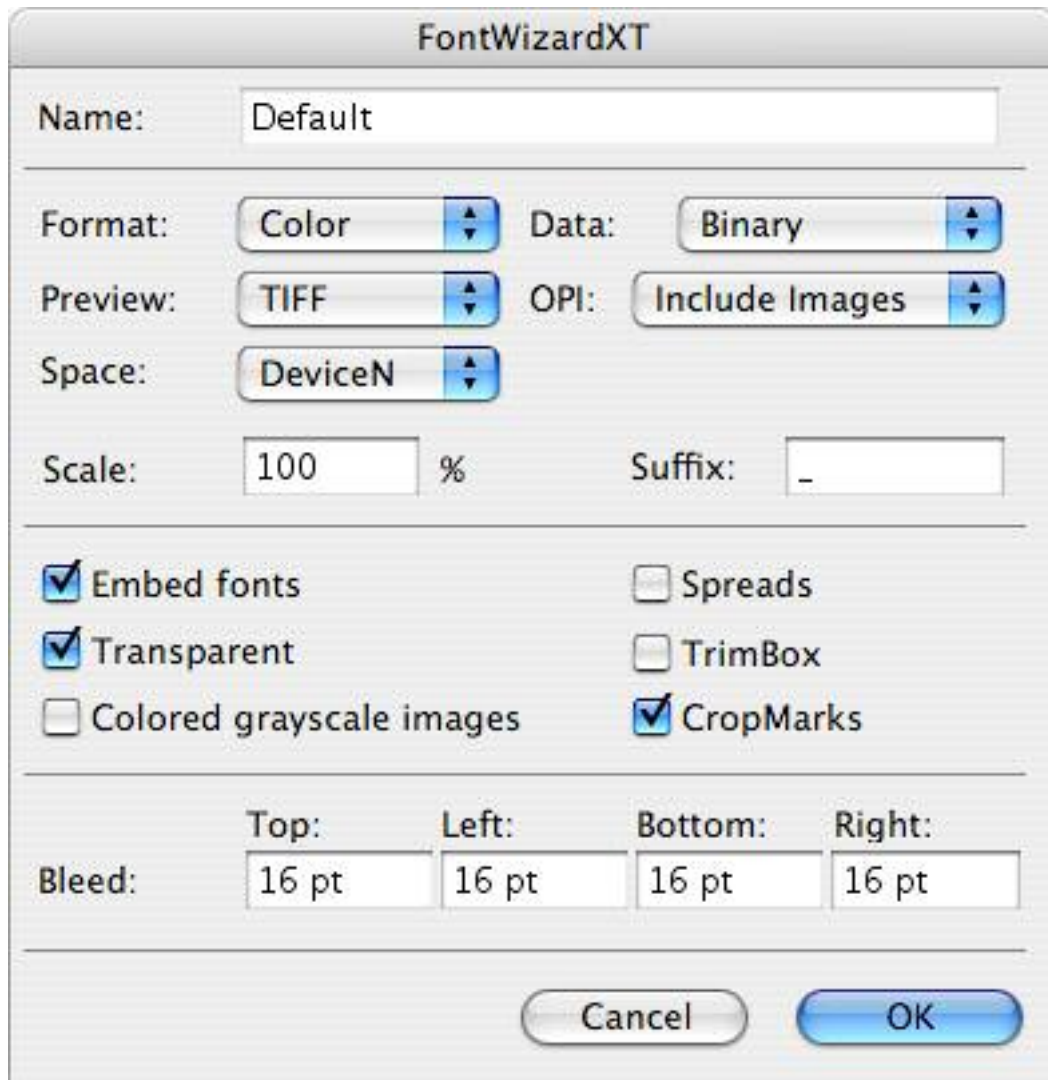
With this option active FontWizardXT creates a logfile for each export, located in the XTension folder and named “FontWizardXT.log”. This logfile can be very useful for debugging in case of missing fonts or other problems during eps export.

- *Use last Folder*

With “Use last Folder” the last used folder is taken as the default folder for the eps export operation.

- *Export styles*

Export styles can be created, changed or deleted. The style “Default” can be changed, but neither renamed or deleted. Double clicking a style opens the following dialog for specifying the according eps settings:

- *Name:*

The name of the export style can be up to 30 characters long.

- *Format:*

The format of the created eps files: Black/White, Color, DCS1 or DCS2.

- *Data:*

With “Data” you can control, whether the eps file can contain binary data (for pixel images). With binary data the size of the eps file will be smaller than with ASCII, but not all printer will be able to process these eps files, especially in Windows environments.

- *Preview:*

The preview type of the eps file: None, Tiff or PICT.

- *OPI:*

Controls, whether images or only references to the images are embedded into the postscript data of the eps. Using “Omit Tiff “ or “Omit Tiff and EPS” requires an OPI print server to embed the HiRes data of the images.

- *Scale:*

Scaling of the eps file.

- *Suffix:*

Specifies the character(s) appended to the name specified in the export dialog (see also 4.3).

- *Embed fonts:*

Controls font embedding. With fonts embedded the eps files can be placed and printed on any other workstation without the used fonts to be available. The setting from the style “Default” controls font embedding, if the eps files are not created with “FontWizardXT”, e.g. with the standard “Save Page as EPS...” dialog or other XTensions.

- *Spread:*

Controls, whether pages side on side should be combined to one eps file.

- *Transparent:*

Controls the transparency of the eps background (QuarkXPress 5 only).

- *TrimBox:*

With “TrimBox” active FontWizardXT adds special Acrobat Distiller commands for exact PDF page parameters (Trim- and MediaBox). Those boxes makes postprocessing much easier in PDF workflows.

- *Colored grayscale images:*

Retains the spot color for colored grayscale images with only a foreground color. Only works when including images.

- *Crop Marks:*

Draws crop marks around the page like for printing.

- *Bleed:*

Specifies bleeding values for the pages.

4.3 Page numbering

If you are exporting multipage documents with “FontWizardXT EPS Export”, FontWizardXT adds a separator char, the page number and the extension “.eps” to the name entered in the export dialog. The chars added can be controlled with the field “Suffix” in the Options dialog. Here some examples:

Suffix:	Name of EPS file	Comment
_	_1.eps, _2.eps, ..., _10.eps	Natural numbers
_%02d	_01.eps, _02.eps, ..., _10.eps	2 digits, leading zero
_%03d	_001.eps, _002.eps, ..., _010.eps	3 digits, leading zero

If the field “Suffix” is empty, only the extension “.eps” is added to the file name.
